German

- 2 spiral notebooks
- 1 package of note cards
- 1 folder to hold handouts and keep them separate from other classes.
- Pen/pencil
- 1 box of tissues
- German/English Dictionary (Larousse, Oxford, Collins, Langenscheidt are good choices)
