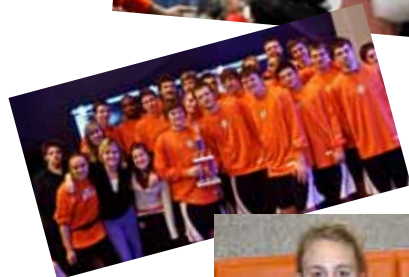

Boys hockey

The SEC champion boys hockey team competed in the state tournament, tying a record by playing three overtime games in the tournament. The team played a total of seven overtime periods during the tournament.

Brandon Wahlin was named a 2A all-tournament team member and Garen David was named the 2A Herb Brooks Award winner. Tim Sager was named Coach of the Year and Chris Anderson was named Assistant Coach of the Year.

Girls basketball

After winning the SEC champion title, the girls basketball team earned fourth place in the state tournament. The team ended the season with a 27-4 overall record.

Boys basketball

The boys basketball team completed their season with a Section Tournament game loss to Stillwater on March 11th. Earlier in the season, the team won the Winona State Holiday Tournament.

Gymnastics

WBLAHS junior gymnast Kellie Dougherty placed fifth in the state in the uneven bar competition. Kellie also represented WBLAHS very well during the season, being named "Athlete of the Week" multiple times for her overall performances.

Eight wrestlers competed as individuals. Beau Bibeau captured third place in his division. Donny Longendyke won the heavyweight title after a triple-overtime match.
